Dear parents/carers,

We know how busy the Christmas holiday can be, but if you have some spare time we were wondering if you would be able to take some time to complete some fun activities with your child.

**Make microwave playdough** – can you and your child think of different ingredients to add into the recipe e.g. spices or food colouring we've attached a recipe!

## Microwave playdough recipe

Ingredients:

1 cup of water

1 cup of flour

2 teaspoons of cream of tartar

1 tablespoon of cooking oil

½ cup of salt

Food colouring

Directions:

Mix all the ingredients together, except the food colouring.

Microwave for about 1 minute then stir.

Microwave for about another 30 seconds.

Keep repeating until the playdough is dough like.

Knead the playdough and add the food colouring.
